2009 KIDS TO CAMP

The YMCA of Metropolitan Detroit & Camp Nissokone announce that it will provide 150 weeks of overnight camp to children of parents who are unemployed or members of the military with a deployed status.

The purpose of this program is to make overnight camp available to families that are experiencing unexpected economic hardship. This KIDS TO CAMP program is in addition to the financial assistance offered through the annual Strong Kids Campaign.

This program is made possible by the generous contributions of YMCA volunteers, friends and community organizations with a history of building strong communities.

Eligibility:

- Children in families where at least one parent is currently receiving unemployment benefits.
- Children in families where at least one parent is a member of the military and currently deployed.

Guidelines:

- Parent(s) must complete the **2009 Kids To Camp application** that includes proof of current unemployment or active military status.
- Families do not need to be current YMCA members to qualify.
- Eligible children must be ages 9-16.
- Each eligible child may attend one week of overnight camp under this program.
- Optional camp programs such as transportation, camp store and Adventure Camp trips are available at an additional fee.
- Applications are being accepted on a “first come, first served” basis and availability is limited in each session offered.
- Once registered, session changes would incur a fee of \$50, and campers are not guaranteed placement in another session.

Availability:

- June 28 – July 4
- July 12 – July 18
- July 26 – August 1
- August 16 – 22
- Bus transportation is available from the Birmingham and Livonia YMCA's.
