

Guest Guidelines

(Effective 4/1/06)

- Guests may only enter the YMCA when accompanied by a member. A member may host a maximum of two (2) members at a time.
- The same non-member can only be a guest once per month with a maximum of two visits per year.
- A guest fee* will be charged for guest usage of the YMCA.
- All guests must present picture identification and complete a registration and waiver of liability form prior to entry into the YMCA.
- A parent or legal guardian must accompany all guests under the age of eighteen (18) or present an authorization form for release of liability signed by a parent or legal guardian prior to using the YMCA.
- Appropriate attire must be worn at all times when using the YMCA. Shoes and shirts are required in all areas outside the locker rooms and pool areas. Only shoes with non-marking soles are allowed on the gymnasium floors.
- In keeping with the YMCA mission of providing programs that help people grow in spirit, mind, and body, the YMCA has established a code of conduct. Guests should practice the character development values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility towards members, other guests and staff. Guests shall abide by the posted guidelines and regulations in activity areas.

*Non member (adult) guest fee is \$10

Non member (under 18) guest fee is \$5
